Notes to the proposed fees

1. Country member subscription to be the same as an ordinary member.
2. Mooring contracts will be charged by hull length over all, subject to a minimum on the marina of 6m.
3. Fees and dues paid by credit card subject to a surcharge of 3%
4. Berth holders may settle their annual berthing fees in five monthly instalments
5. Berth holders who settle their annual berthing fees by January 31st may take a 3% prompt payment discount.
6. Payment in full will be required from those taking up a berth part way through the year.
7. Any member in genuine difficulties settling their berthing fees may apply to the MC for a variation to the above.
8. Berthholder requesting a refund may be offered a recalculation of the berthing charge based upon the "LongTerm Visitor" rate and any overpayment from that, less an administration charge of £20, may be refunded.
